

Drawing Supplies

Note: Painting supplies are on a separate sheet. Be sure you have both pages.

Crow quill pen: The removable nib is steel, and should be quite firm. “Crow quill” is not a type of pen, but a specific size of point... it is quite small.

White ink: I like Higgins, but any brand will do, as long as the ink is opaque.

Kneaded Eraser: Any brand.

Drawing Pencil: Regular graphite pencil, HB lead.

Pigma Micron Pen, point size 01: Feel free to substitute other waterproof drafting/drawing pens such as Rapidograph or Pitt, as long as the ink is waterproof and the point size is 01 or very close.
