

Painting Supplies

Note: Drawing supplies are on a separate sheet. Be sure you have both pages.

Watercolors: In tubes, any brand you like. You will need the colors shown at left: alizarin crimson, cadmium red, cadmium yellow light, ultramarine blue and phthalo blue.

Brushes: I love the yellow nylon “golden taklon” synthetic brushes, which are inexpensive and perform very well. Sometimes they are called “synthetic sable.” Of course, if you already have REAL sable in these sizes, that’s fine, too. You will need a #10 round, #4 round, #1 round and a 1/2 inch angular.

Watercolor paper: Any brand of 140 lb. cold pressed; look for paper without a pronounced surface texture. One pad of 11x14 (or larger). If you are using 22x30 loose sheets, three should be enough.
