You will also need something to use as a **palette** – I use an old white china plate, but you may prefer an actual palette (ceramic or glass). Any type will do.

I recommend using **two large containers** for rinsing your brushes, so that your water stays relatively clear. I use gallon jars. In a pinch, you can cut the tops off gallon milk jugs for a quick and handy solution.
