2B drawing pencil (any brand you like)

Kneaded eraser

Some practice/sketch paper (even copy paper will work for this)

Drawing paper: Strathmore Bristol Vellum OR a good-quality bright white cardstock

Pencil sharpener (sharp points are vital!)

Small tube of black gouache, any brand

2 watercolor brushes:

- Small round (size 00, 0, 1 or 2)
- Larger round OR flat (size 4 to 10)

IMPORTANT: Avoid store brand art supplies (Master's Touch, Artist's Loft) from Michaels or Hobby Lobby stores. The quality is so poor that they can be difficult to use properly.
