

Supply List:

The Best Nest: Birds, Nests & Eggs in Colored Pencil

Feel free to email studio@valwebb.com with any questions about supplies – you are welcome to substitute materials you already have, if you like. Your results may be slightly different, but that's fine.

NOTE: Our field sparrow project uses a technique that will only work with a wax-based colored pencil (I use Prismacolor).

Here is our list:

- 2B drawing pencil, any brand
- HB drawing pencil, any brand
- Kneaded eraser
- Sketch/practice paper (I use ordinary copy paper)
- 5 sheets of drawing paper (Good quality card stock works well, or hot press watercolor paper, or Bristol vellum) either 8.5x11 or 9x12 inches
- A ruler
- An X-Acto knife or a razor blade
- Prismacolor Premiere (“regular” Prismacolors, not the Prismacolor Verithins) in these colors:
 - ~ Black
 - ~ White
 - ~ Cream
 - ~ Dark Umber (get 2)
 - ~ Burnt Ochre
 - ~ Canary Yellow
 - ~ Rose
 - ~ True Blue
 - ~ Spring Green
 - ~ Process Red
